### An original guide to creating an egg-ceptional Easter broadcast with OneStream Live!

### 1. Select a Clear Theme

- Choose a simple theme (Family Gathering, Spring DIY, Easter Trivia Night, Easter Sermon).
- Align your content plan and visuals around this theme using OneStream Live's branding overlays.

# 3. Set Up Your Broadcasting Space

- Simple seasonal decor (flowers, pastel banners, tasteful props) without going overboard.
- Double-check your camera, lighting, and audio clarity within OneStream Live Studio's preview function.

### 2. Plan Stream Content

- Outline key segments clearly: introduction, interactive activity, main content, audience Q&A.
- Mix live and pre-recorded segments seamlessly with OneStream Live's Pre-recorded Streaming to keep things smooth and professional.

### 4. Technical Preparation

- Keep your lines smooth with the built-in Teleprompter, so you never lose track of your script when painting eggs or greeting guests.
- Use **Multicamera Streaming** for showcasing multiple angles.

### 5. Schedule Smartly

- Use OneStream Live's Advanced Scheduling feature to set clear start and end times.
- Announce your stream in advance across your social channels or website to maximize attendance.

### 7. Audience Engagement

- Keep the interaction genuine: ask straightforward questions, encourage audience discussion.
- Moderate and respond to comments easily from multiple platforms using OneStream Live's Unified Chat feature.

### 9. Record & Repurpose

- Always record your stream for later use (highlights, promotional clips, replay streams).
- Quickly access your saved broadcasts using OneStream
   Live's cloud storage integration
   (Google Drive, Dropbox, etc.).

### 11. Professional Multistreaming

- Maximize reach by multistreaming simultaneously on 45+ platforms, using OneStream Live.
- Tailor stream titles and descriptions to include relevant keywords to boost searchability.





## 6. Optimize Your Easter Stream

- Add "Easter" or "Spring Celebration" to your stream titles, descriptions, and tags for better discoverability.
- Mention family-friendly or holiday fun to attract a wider audience.

### 8. Host or Embed?

- Decide whether you'll direct traffic to an existing platform or create a dedicated Easter landing page. A Hosted Live Page can provide a fully branded environment—use your own domain and add interactive CTAs for maximum impact.
- If you prefer to keep everything on your website, **Embed Players** let you stream directly without forcing your audience to leave your site.

### 10. Extend the Holiday Fun

- Create a playlist of past Easter or springtime events and schedule them to go live automatically.
- Use video looping to replay your top moments or behind-the-scenes clips.

### 12. Reflect & Analyze

- After the stream ends, review audience engagement data through OneStream's real-time analytics.
- Learn from each broadcast and continually refine your future streaming strategies.
